ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
NO. 2000-073

Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Arizona, Art. 6, Sec. 24, A.R.S. §12-213, as amended, and Rule 91 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, it is

**ORDERED** that R. Jeffrey Woodburn is hereby appointed as a Court Commissioner of the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County, effective January 1, 2001, on a full time basis, with the working title of "Hearing Officer".

**ORDERED** that R. Jeffrey Woodburn shall have all such powers and duties pursuant to law which shall include, but not be limited to, those powers and duties prescribed by A.R.S. §12-213, as amended, and Rule 91, Rules of the Supreme Court, as amended.

**ORDERED** that R. Jeffrey Woodburn is assigned to hear any matter within the purview of his powers pursuant to law.

**ORDERED** that R. Jeffrey Woodburn shall receive compensation at an annual salary of \$90,562.50 total. This appointment is conditioned upon his agreement to serve only for the compensation received as a Court Commissioner/Hearing Officer, and to receive no additional compensation or benefit, fiscal or otherwise, when he acts in the capacity of a Judge Pro Tempore, unless funds are made available by the Administrative Office of the Courts.
